The actual SD40-2 engine was introduced in 1964. The Electro-Motive Division of General Motors (EMD) manufactured 4,447 of these locomotives until they halted production in 1986.

Conrail became a corporation on April 1, 1976 with an

inheritance of SD40-2s, among other locomotives, from six bankrupt railroads. Conrail quickly became a major player in the railroad scene with its blue paint body and the wheels on rail logo.

Southern Pacific GP-20

Southern Pacific GP-20s were built between 1960 and 1962 by EMD. These units were mostly used on branch line and yard duty assignments, occasionally finding themselves on mainline coal trains. Southern Pacific, now Union Pacific, still uses these locomotives in today's contemporary railroading.

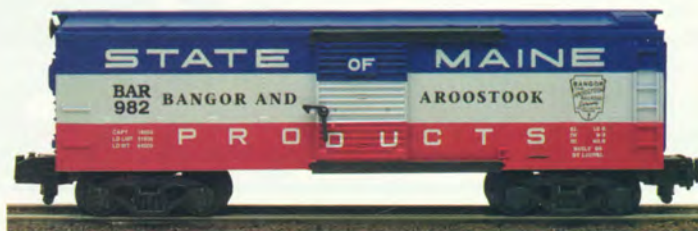
